

VILLAGE OF PALMYRA SEWER DEPARTMENT



The Village of Palmyra is served by a wastewater collection and treatment system consisting of 10.5 miles of sewer mains, 5 lift stations and a wastewater treatment facility. The Village of Palmyra Sewer Department also accepts sewage from the Blue Spring Lake Sanitary District. The wastewater treatment facility has an average flow of 197,000 gallons per day through its three pond system. Combined, these three ponds hold approximately 9 million gallons of sewage on a day to day basis for treatment. Annually the DPW performs maintenance cleaning of all sewer mains and lift stations. Day to day operation of the treatment plant, lab testing and the maintenance of the treatment plant and collection system is performed by the DPW as well. Billing for sewer usage is done on a quarterly basis, coinciding with water billing, in March, June, September and December.
