

VILLAGE OF PALMYRA WATER DEPARTMENT



The Village of Palmyra is served by a groundwater and distribution system that contains two wells and an elevated storage tank. Well #1 was drilled in 1913 to a depth of 172' and Well #3 was drilled in 1980 to a depth of 90'. Well #2 was originally drilled in 1936, but was permanently abandoned in 1986. The two active wells have a combined pumping capacity of roughly 850 gallons per minute to supply the distribution system. The 200,000 gallon water tower was constructed in 1980 and serves as the water storage area and source of water pressure for the Village. Daily system operations, maintenance and lab testing is performed by the DPW. Annual maintenance such as the flushing of the 12.19 miles of main, operation and maintenance of the 180 main valves and operation and maintenance of the 122 fire hydrants in the system is performed by the DPW. Water meters are read and billed on a quarterly basis in the Village in March, June, September and December.
