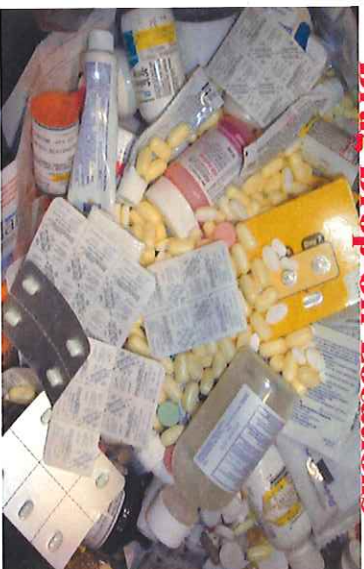

Keep liquid medications in their original containers and place in plastic bags or tape the caps. We don't want pill containers or wrappings (except for the liquids) in our drug boxes.**
