### BRUSH CHIPPING

**Have materials at the curb by 7:00 A.M.**

Curbside pickup for brush:

Brush must be no more than 4 inches in diameter, no greater than 8 feet in length and neatly stacked in piles with cut ends toward the road. Do not bundle or place in bags or containers. No grass, leaves, or other yard debris allowed. This meant for general yard maintenance, NOT tree removal.

**Second Monday of each month April-Nov.**

### YARDWASTE SITE OPENS

Village of Palmyra Yardwaste Site will be open the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturday of each month April-Nov. 8 am-noon. To Village Residents ONLY. Site is located at 430 Jefferson St. DO NOT LEAVE MATERIALS OUTSIDE OF THE POSTED DATE AND TIME. THIS IS A VIOLATION OF VILLAGE ORDINANCES AND YOU MAY RECEIVE A CITATION. NO E-WASTE DROP OFFS AT THIS SITE EFFECT. JAN. 1ST, 2015

Our contracted garbage and recycling hauler will not pickup any of the following banned electronics: Computers, monitors, TV's, DVRs, fax machines, VCRs, basically anything with a cord. **E-WASTE SITE IS CLOSED PERMANENTLY!**
